## Individualised Training Packages

APC can adapt our training packages to meet the needs of our clients. Being at Australian RTO we must ensure we cover our nationally accredited course requirements to meet the local standards, but for our international clients we can tailor our packages to include relevant national legislation, locally recognised standards of health care – including skills, procedural protocols and pharmacology (Drug Therapy Protocols). This will ensure our clients have the most relevant

training to meet their own needs rather than having to follow Australian standards and have to adapt this to their own requirements. We recently adapted and developed a Certificate in IV Health Care to specifically meet the needs of the National Rugby League (NRL) within Australia, with a focus of management of spinal and head injuries whilst still maintaining the requirements to meet the nationally recognised qualification.





## Mixed Learning Styles

APC offer a combination of distance education, and face-to-face components for all courses. Our Student Portal provides our participants with all of their resources and assessment material to complete their theoretical components at their own pace, in their own time. APC provide workshops throughout the year to meet the requirements of the practical components of the course. The practical workshops are a focus of the training as the skills and

knowledge developed through the theoretical part of the course must be able to be put into practice competently. Our training centre is situated on the Gold Coast in Queensland, Australia. We are located within 15 minutes of the Gold Coast International Airport, surrounded by accommodation complexes. APC can also arrange for practical workshops to be conducted at our client's locations nationally, or internationally.
